STEPS UNTIL ACCEPTANCE

1 Online Application:

After the nomination, students will receive information to **submit an application on our system, Fenix**



2 Learning Agreement (LA):

Students must **send us a Learning Agreement**, approved and signed by the home institution, **until the application's deadline**

Learning Agreements are acceptable in **pdf** or as an **Online Learning Agreement (OLA)**



3 Acceptance:

Students are only accepted for a mobility period once they receive **an acceptance e-mail and the LA signed** by the responsible person

Important note:

Upon arrival, all **students are charged an administrative fee**, which also **contemplates accident and liability insurance** during their stay



LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor's Courses:

Bachelor's courses are fully taught in Portuguese

Applicants are exempted from providing proficiency certificates in English/ Portuguese if they are **native speakers** and/or have **completed secondary education in a country in which these are official languages**
