

## CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

### 1 (one) Research Fellowship(s) for R&D Initiation (BII)

1 Research Fellowship(s) for R&D Initiation (BII) is(are) open at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the project “ATLANTICDIVERSA - Use emergent technologies to understand the role of cleaning mutualisms in Atlantic biodiversity conservation, Ref. 2024/0028”, financed by Fundação Luso-Americana para o Desenvolvimento, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Biological Sciences
2. **Admission requirements:** Bachelor in Biological Sciences, Diving certification (Open Water Diver).
3. **Additional optional skills and qualifications:** Experience with R and Python programming languages. Fieldwork experience (e.g., transects and recording behavioural interactions). Scuba diving experience.
4. **Contracting requirements:** Presentation of the academic qualifications and/or diplomas. Enrolment in Master's degree or in a non-degree course developed in association or cooperation between a High Education Institution and one or multiple research units.
5. **Work plan:** Underwater surveys (transects and behavioural sampling); sampling of marine animals; classification of fish identities for training artificial intelligence models.
6. **Legislation framework:** Research Fellowship Holder Statute, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, in its current version and the FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, in its current version (Reg. 950/2019 published in DR on 16<sup>th</sup> December: <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>, or at the FCT website: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml>), and FCiências.ID Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 (available at [Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação Científica da FCiências.ID](#)).
7. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at the MARE – Centro de Ciências do Mar e do Ambiente, from Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, at the facilities of Laboratório Marítimo da Guia (Cascais) under the scientific supervision of Professor José Ricardo Paula.
8. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 3 months due to start in December 2024. The fellowship contract may be potentially renewed for 9 months, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P and FCiências.ID Fellowship Regulation.
9. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 601,12, according to [table values](#) of the FCiências.ID Fellowship Regulation. The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, if not covered by any other social protection scheme, pursuant to *Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social*. The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.
10. **Evaluation and selection process:** Candidates will be assessed by a) curriculum evaluation (75%) and b) motivation letter (25%). The panel may choose to conduct an interview with the top 3 (three) ranked candidates based on the total scores from criteria a) and b). In this case, the sum of the evaluations obtained in the assessment criteria a) and b) will correspond to 85% of the final grade, and the interview to 15%.

Applicants whose application is scored with a final classification of less than 50 points are not eligible for granting a fellowship.

11. **Selection Committee:** Dr. José R. Paula (President of the Jury); Dr. Tiago Repolho (1st Effective Member); Prof. Rui Rosa (2nd Effective Member); Dr. Catherine Sheppard (1st Substitute Member), and Dr. Viviana Brambilla (2nd Substitute Member).

12. **Publication/notification of results:** All the candidates will be notified by e-mail, sent by the call holder, with the selection meeting minutes enclosed.

13. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from 26/11/2024 to 09/12/2024 .

- a. Curriculum vitae;
- b. Certificate of completion of previous degree <sup>Note 1, 2;</sup>
- c. Motivation letter;
- d. Diving certificate (Open Water Diver).

15. **Processing of personal data:** FCIências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências, as the controller under the General Data Protection Regulation, collects and processes the personal data requested in the context indicated in paragraph 14., under the legitimate interests in ensuring the award of the research fellowship to candidates with the indicated profile.

The personal data will be kept for the period necessary for the execution of the purposes for which they are intended, being ensured the processing and protection in an appropriate and diligent way, the confidentiality and integrity of these data, through appropriate technical and organizational measures.

Personal data may be transmitted to third parties, namely the entity funding the research project, solely for the purposes specifically established. In this sense, whenever the transfer of personal data to countries outside the European Union and/or international organizations is necessary, compliance with the applicable legal provisions is ensured.

16. **Time limits for the appeal procedure:** In case of negative decision, the candidates have 10 business days, after the date of announcement of the results of the candidates evaluation, to pronounce their disagreement in accordance with the *Código do Procedimento Administrativo*. Appeals against the final decision may be submitted to the Administration Board of FCIências.ID ([fciencias.id@fciencias-id.pt](mailto:fciencias.id@fciencias-id.pt)) within 15 business days after the notification date.

**Note 1:** The documents that prove the entitlement of the academic qualifications and diplomas can be dismissed during the application period and replaced by a declaration on their honour from the applicant ([Minuta PT](#), [Minute EN](#)). Their delivery is mandatory for the fellowship contractualization.
