Offer Description

At the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Lisbon (Ciências ULisboa), a call is open for awarding 1 (one) research initiation scholarship at the **Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa** (Ciências ULisboa), financed by CIÊNCIAS ULisboa, with the following conditions:

Work plan:

- Administration of computer systems;
- Preparation and maintenance of equipment and laboratories;
- Preparation and management of software installed on laboratory computers, ensuring its availability;
- Support for teaching and research activities, namely managing information systems and the provided services;
- Process automation.

Fellowship duration:

The research initiation grant is scheduled to start in January 2025. The contract, with an initial duration of 6 (six) months, on an exclusive basis, may possibly be renewed once for an equal period of 6 (six) months.

Form of presentation of applications:

Applications may be sent by e-mail, to the address candidaturas@ciencias.ulisboa.pt, with the reference "BII-DI-5", under penalty of not being considered for the competition.

Applications must be accompanied, compulsorily and under penalty of exclusion, by the following documents. No document, which must be submitted at the time of application, may be submitted after the deadline for submission:

- Personal data form and declaration of consent for communication of results via e-mail;
- Declaration under oath;
- Proof of enrolment, in the 2024/2025 academic year, in the scientific area of Computer Science and Engineering, in a technical higher vocational course, a bachelor's degree, an integrated master's degree or a master's degree or proof of holding a bachelor's degree and being enrolled in a course that does not confer an academic degree integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, developed in association or cooperation with R&D units;
- Detailed and updated Curriculum Vitae;
- Photocopy of the qualification certificate(s) of the academic degree(s) required, if applicable;
 - If the academic degree, required in the present announcement as an admission requirement for the type of scholarship in question, was obtained abroad, one of the following documents must be submitted: (See also the NOTES below)

- Document proving the granting, by a Portuguese Institution, of the recognition or equivalence or registration of the academic degree;
- Document proving that an application for the recognition of the degree has been made, which must be submitted by the deadline for receipt of applications, inclusive.

Notes:

1) The presentation of the proof of obtaining the recognition or equivalence or registration of the academic degree is a mandatory condition for signing the contract;

2) For academic degrees obtained in foreign countries, which have not yet obtained either recognition or equivalence or registration of the degree, it is necessary to recognise it, under the terms provided for in Decree Law no. 66/2018, of 16 August, combined with Ordinance no. 33/2019, of 25 January, as currently amended.

- The candidate must be enrolled in a Professional Higher Technical Course/Bachelor's Degree/Integrated MSc/MSc or must have a Bachelor's Degree and be enrolled in a course that does not confer an academic degree integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, developed in association or cooperation with units of R&D, in the academic year 2024/2025, in the scientific area of Computer Science and Engineering.

If the academic degree required by the present announcement as an admission requirement for the type of grant in question was obtained abroad, the requirements mentioned in point "Form of presentation of applications" of this announcement regarding the qualification certificates shall be taken into consideration.

Specific Requirements

Preference will be given to candidates fulfilling the following preferential requirements:

- Immediate availability;
- Experience in the area of computer systems configuration and management;
- Knowledge of security and good practices in information systems and networks;
- Experience in computer networks, namely TCP/IP and equipment;
- Good self-training and updating skills;
- Good interpersonal skills.

Monthly allowance and social security:

- The fellowship amount corresponds to € 601.12 (six hundred and one euros, twelve cents), according to FCT Regulation for Research Fellowships, published by Regulation no. 950/2019 in the Diário da República, 2nd series, no. 241, of 16th of December, amended by Regulation No. 643/2021, published in the Diário da República, 2nd Series, No. 135, of 14 July, and available in the link:

- It will be paid monthly by bank transfer;
- The candidate to be hired may exercise his right to social insurance by joining the voluntary social insurance scheme, under the terms of the Statute of the Research Fellowship. The financing entities

bear the costs resulting from the contributions provided for this Social Insurance, according to the Statute of the Research Fellowship.

Selection process

Selection criteria:

The applicable selection methods will be curricular evaluation and, possibly, a selection interview.

If the jury chooses to conduct a selection interview, it will be conducted with the 4 (four) candidates with the best classification in the curricular assessment.

In the event that the selection interview is held, the final evaluation will be obtained considering the following weightings: 50% for the curricular evaluation and 50% for the selection interview.

The selection methods are eliminatory, with candidates who obtain a rating lower than 9.5 in one of the selection methods or phases of the procedure being excluded, and the following method or phase will not be applied to them.

All candidates will be notified of the final result of the evaluation, sent to the email address used for sending the respective application, or by post, to the address given in the Personal Data Form, through a sorted list, in descending order of the final evaluation obtained.


