1 (one) Research Fellowship (BI) for BSc enrolled in a non-degree course

1 Research Fellowship(s) (BI) is(are) open at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the project “PlasticTrace - Tracing Micro and NanoPlastics in Food and Environment”, financed by European Partnership on Metrology, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Analytical Chemistry – Metrology and Examinology in Chemistry
2. **Admission requirements:** Bachelor’s degree in Chemistry or similar.
3. **Additional optional skills and qualifications:** Experience in metrology and examinology in chemistry (sciences of quantitative and qualitative chemical analysis) is valued.
4. **Contracting requirements:** Presentation of the academic qualifications and/or diplomas. Enrolment in a non-degree course developed in association or cooperation between a High Education Institution and one or multiple research units.
5. **Work plan:** The contracted person must collaborate in the collection and processing of quantitative and qualitative data on the presence of microplastics in food and food matrices. After identifying and quantifying the sources of uncertainty, the uncertainty components will be combined using various algorithms and numerical tools.
6. **Legislation framework:** Research Fellowship Holder Statute, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, in its current version and the FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, in its current version (Reg. 950/2019 published in DR on 16th December: <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>, or at the FCT website: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml.pt>), and FCIências.ID Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 12th May 2020 (available at [Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação Científica da FCIências.ID](#)).
7. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at the Centro de Química Estrutural – Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa under the scientific supervision of Professor Ricardo J. N. Bettencourt da Silva.
8. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 3 months due to start in March 2025. The fellowship contract may be potentially renewed for 3 months.
9. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 1259,64, according to [table values](#) of the FCIências.ID Fellowship Regulation. The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, if not covered by any other social protection scheme, pursuant to *Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social*. The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.
10. **Evaluation and selection process:** Candidates will be assessed by curriculum evaluation (80%) and motivation letter (20%). If necessary, an interview will be carried out with the 3 (three) best candidates. If there is an interview, in which case the weighting will be as follows: Curriculum evaluation (70%), motivation letter (15%) and interview (15%). Applicants whose application is scored with a final classification of less than 90 points are not eligible for granting a fellowship.
11. **Selection Committee:** President of the jury: Ricardo Bettencourt da Silva; effective members: Cristina M. Oliveira and Virginia Ferreira; alternate members: Olinda Monteiro and Helena Gaspar.

12. **Publication/notification of results:** All the candidates will be notified by e-mail, sent by the call holder, with the selection meeting minutes enclosed.

13. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from 28/01/2025 to 07/02/2025 .

14. **Application:** Applications should be sent via e-mail to rjsilva@fc.ul.pt, by attaching the following documents:

- a. Curriculum vitae;
- b. Certificate of completion of previous degree ^{Note 1, 2;}
- c. Motivation letter.

15. **Processing of personal data:** FCIências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências, as the controller under the General Data Protection Regulation, collects and processes the personal data requested in the context indicated in paragraph 14., under the legitimate interests in ensuring the award of the research fellowship to candidates with the indicated profile.

The personal data will be kept for the period necessary for the execution of the purposes for which they are intended, being ensured the processing and protection in an appropriate and diligent way, the confidentiality and integrity of these data, through appropriate technical and organizational measures.

Personal data may be transmitted to third parties, namely the entity funding the research project, solely for the purposes specifically established. In this sense, whenever the transfer of personal data to countries outside the European Union and/or international organizations is necessary, compliance with the applicable legal provisions is ensured.

16. **Time limits for the appeal procedure:** In case of negative decision, the candidates have 10 business days, after the date of announcement of the results of the candidates evaluation, to pronounce their disagreement in accordance with the *Código do Procedimento Administrativo*. Appeals against the final decision may be submitted to the Administration Board of FCIências.ID (fciencias.id@fciencias-id.pt) within 15 business days after the notification date.

Note 1: The documents that prove the entitlement of the academic qualifications and diplomas can be dismissed during the application period and replaced by a declaration on their honour from the applicant ([Minuta PT](#), [Minute EN](#)). Their delivery is mandatory for the fellowship contractualization.

Note 2: Please note that - higher education degrees and diplomas awarded by foreign higher education institutions need to be recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution, pursuant to the [Decree-Law nr. 66/2018](#) (August 16) and the [Ministerial Order nr. 33/2019](#) (January 25).
