



CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

Post-Doc fellowship, one vacancy

One Post-Doc Fellowship for PhD graduates is(are) open at the **Fundação da Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa**, for the project "*ASTARTE— Assessment, Strategy And Risk Reduction for Tsunamis in Europe*", (contract 603839) at the Instituto Dom Luiz, co-financed by the European Commission under the Seventh Framework Programme, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Physical Oceanography, Atmospheric Sciences, Earth Sciences or Engineering.
2. **Requirements for admission:** The candidate should hold a PhD in one of the required scientific areas. A solid mathematical background and programming skills are required. Experience in coastal modelling will be highly valued. Candidates with a submitted PhD thesis may apply as long as the defence takes place before the beginning of the grant period.
3. **Work plan:** The goal of the fellowship is to investigate and provide recommendations towards the integration of tide and atmospheric-driven extreme sea level event forecast in future Tsunami early-warning systems.
4. **Legislation framework:** A fellowship contract will be celebrated according to the regulations defined by FCT "Regulations for Advanced Training and Qualification of Human Resources", in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended and republished by Decree-Law No. 202/2012 of 27 August, and as amended by Decree-Law No. 233/2012 of 29 October and by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, and Decree-Law No. 89/2013 of 9 July. And also by the FCT, I.P. Fellowships Regulation of 2013 approved by Regulation No. 234/2012, of June 25, as amended by Regulation No 326/2013 of 27 August 2013, in force (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml)
5. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at the Instituto Dom Luiz under the scientific guidance of Professors Álvaro Peliz, Carlos Antunes and Luis Matias.
6. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 14 months and will begin on the 1st June 2014.
7. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 1495.00, according to table values of the fellowships awarded directly by the FCT, IP. (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).
The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and, if not covered by any social protection scheme can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, pursuant to Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social. The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.
8. **Selection method:** Candidates will be evaluated by the quality of their CV (50 %) and an interview (50%). The jury may decide not to attribute the fellowship if none of the candidates is found fit to fulfil the work plan in the required time.
9. **Selection Committee:** President Álvaro Peliz, effective members Carlos Antunes and Luis Matias, alternate member Rui Taborda.
10. **Publication/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will become public, through an ordered list by final grade obtained which will be posted at the entrance hall of the **Fundação da Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa**, located at the Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, C1 bdg – 3rd floor, Campo Grande, 1749-016 Lisboa, and the selected candidate will be notified by e-mail.
