



CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

1 – Research Fellowship

One (1) Fellowship Research Grant for Master Degree is open at the **Fundação da Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa**, for the project CIRAC - Cartas de Inundação e Risco de Cheias em Cenários de Alterações Climáticas financed by Associação Portuguesa de Seguradores under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Climate Change

2. **Requirements for admission:**

The candidate must have a Master degree in Natural Sciences and:

- Previous knowledge and/or working experience in areas related with Climate Change Adaptation
- Excellent English communication skills (written and spoken) is mandatory* (knowledge of other languages may be valorised);
- Intermediate-level IT skills required*;
- Previous working experience with database management will be highly valorised;
- Previous experience in event organisation (meeting/conference level) and group moderation skills will be highly valorised;
- Availability to travel abroad;
- Dynamic and proactive personality.

*Mandatory requirement (exclusion criteria)

3. **Work plan:** Monitoring of teams involved in the project and support to the coordination; organization of meetings and workshops; Implementation of the map server designed by the project. Follow up of the project results. Scientific revision of the deliverables.

4. **Legislation framework:** A fellowship contract will be celebrated according to the regulations defined by FCT “Regulations for Advanced Training and Qualification of Human Resources”, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended and republished by Decree-Law No. 202/2012 of 27 August, and as amended by Decree-Law No. 233/2012 of 29 October and by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, and Decree-Law No. 89/2013 of 9 July. And also by the FCT, I.P. Fellowships Regulation of 2013 approved by Regulation No. 234/2012, of June 25, as amended by Regulation No 326/2013 of 27 August 2013, in force (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml)

5. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at Laboratório de Sistemas, Instrumentação e Modelação em Ciências e Tecnologias do Ambiente e do Espaço (SIM), da Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa under the scientific guidance of Professor Filipe Duarte Santos.

6. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 3 months and will begin on the 1st of May 2014. The fellowship contract may be renewed to more 3 months, until one total duration of 6 months or eventually until the end date of the project, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P. – 2013.

7. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 980 according to table values of the fellowships awarded directly by the FCT, IP. (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).

The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and, if not covered by any social protection scheme can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, pursuant to Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social.

The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.

8. **Selection method:** Candidates will be assessed by the quality of their CV (70%) and Interview (30%)
