



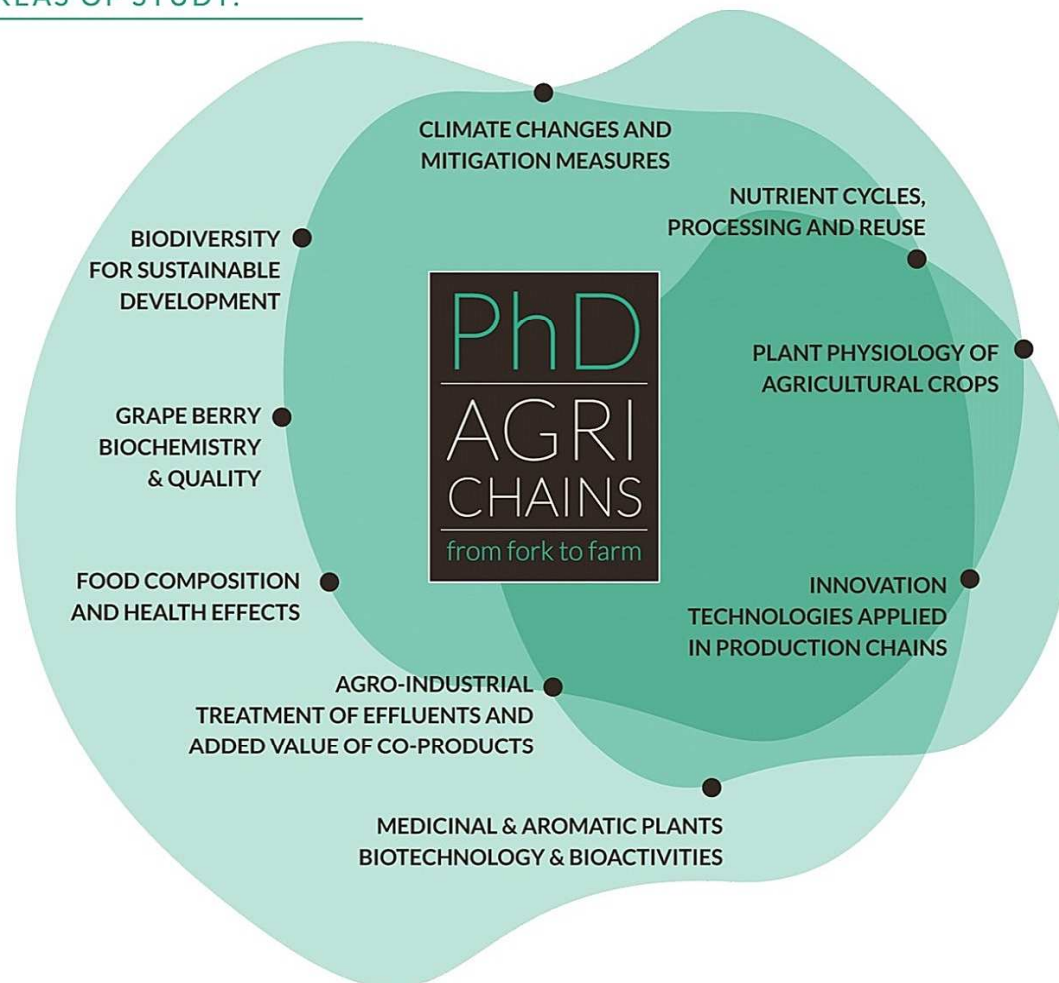

AREAS OF STUDY:



The Agricultural Production Chains – From Fork to Farm (AgriChains) responds to a continued trend in consumer demands and concerns by focusing on training in each step of the production value chain to achieve sustainable food production, and better food quality. Results of consumer feedback, discussed in collaboration with key stakeholder companies, will be incorporated into both the production chain and the AgriChains programme.

The AgriChains programme is designed to meet student demands to improve knowledge and skills that allow them to contribute to developing a more competitive chain. All students will be allocated an academic tutor immediately after acceptance into the AgriChains programme. The academic tutor will provide both personal and academic support and will also act in the selection of the PhD thesis supervisor.

The PhD programme is based on the quality, experience and expertise of the national and international team institutions.

The programme is coordinated by Centre for the Research and Technology of Agro-Environmental and Biological Sciences (CITAB/UTAD and CITAB/Pole of University of Minho) in collaboration with the Chemistry Centre of Vila Real (CQVR). Teaching and training relies on the expertise and excellence of AgriChains international partners, the Polytechnic University of València (UPV) and Wageningen University (WUR).
