

## CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

### 1 Post-Doctoral Fellowships (BPD) in Mycology

One post-doctoral fellowships (Bolsa de pós-doutoramento) for PhD holders is opened at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e o Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, at BioISI (UID/Multi/04046/2013)- Biosystems and Integrative Sciences Institute, with financial support provided by the FCT/MCTES through National funds, under the following conditions:

- 1) **Scientific Area:** Phytopathology, sub-area of Mycology
- 2) **Requirements for admission:** Candidates should be holders of a **PhD** degree in Biology and have research experience corresponding to an h index of at least 20.
- 3) **Factors preferred:** Candidates with experience in Dothideomycetes taxonomy will be preferred.
- 4) **Work plan:** the selected candidate will work in molecular characterization, taxonomy and population genetics of a collection of *Diplodia corticola* isolates.
- 5) **Legislation framework:** Statute of the Scientific Research Fellowship, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended and republished by Decree-Law No. 202/2012 of 27 August, and as amended by Decree-Law No. 233/2012 of 29 October and by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, and Decree-Law No. 89/2013 of 9 July; And also by the FCT, I.P. Fellowships Regulation, in force (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2015.pdf>) and **FCiências.ID** Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2017.
- 6) **Place of work:** The work will be developed at BioISI - Biosystems and Integrative Sciences Institute, at Lab Bugworkers associated with the Microbiology & Biotechnology Research Group.
- 7) **Fellowship duration:** This position is open for 6 months and will begin on May 2017, eventually renewable until the end date of the project in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.
- 8) **Monthly allowance:** The amount of the scholarship amounts to € 1.495, according to table values of the fellowships awarded directly by the FCT, IP in the country (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>). The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and, if not covered by any social protection scheme can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, pursuant to "Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social". The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.
- 9) **Selection method:** Candidates will be assessed by the quality of their CV (70%) and experience in the fungal taxonomy (30%) and classified on a scale of 0 to 20. An interview may be used to resolve eventual ties (through Skype for non-residents) and classified also on a scale from 0 to 20. In this case the final classification will be the average between the curricular evaluation and the interview.
- 10) **Selection Committee:** Prof. Rogério Tenreiro (President), FCUL; Prof. Margarida Amaral ("Vogal"), FCUL; Prof. Ana Tenreiro, FCUL ("Vogal"). (Substitute "Vogais": Prof. Lélia Chambel; Dr. Ricardo Dias).
- 11) **Publication/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will become public, through alphabetically ordered list (selected or rejected) which will be posted at the entrance hall of the F.Ciências.ID, located at the Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, C1 bdg – 3rd floor, Campo Grande, 1749-016 Lisboa, and the selected candidate will be notified by e-mail.
- 12) **Deadline:** This call for applications is open from **15<sup>th</sup> May – 26<sup>th</sup> May 2017**
