One Research Fellowship

One Research Fellowship for graduate students is open at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the project/R&D institution CLIMARES - Long-term assessment of climate induced regime shifts in Coastal Areas, PTDC/CTA-GEO/28412/2017, financed by national funds by FCT / MCTES (PIDDAC) under the Programme All Scientific Domains, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Coastal Processes, Coastal Geodynamics.
2. **Requirements for admission:** Degree in Geology, Marine Sciences or akin areas. Good knowledge of spoken and written English.
3. **Factors preferred:** Provided knowledge in sediment analyses (granulometry, organic matter, calcium carbonate content, etc); Experience in the use of isotopic data (Pb, Cs, C, N) and elemental analysis in sediments; Experience in the use of GIS tools to study the evolution of estuarine or coastal environments; International experience.
4. **Work plan:** High resolution analysis of sedimentary indicators and elemental and isotopic analysis to characterize the impact of long-term (secular) sea level rise in estuarine environment.
5. **Legislation framework:** Statute of the Scientific Research Fellowship, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended and republished by Decree-Law No. 202/2012 of 27 August, and as amended by Decree-Law No. 233/2012 of 29 October and by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, and Decree-Law No. 89/2013 of 9 July; And also by the FCT, I.P. Fellowships Regulation, in force (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT.pdf>) and **FCiências.ID** Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 23rd February 2017.
6. **Place of work:** The work will be developed within the Earth Surface Processes group at the Instituto Dom Luiz under the scientific guidance of António Manoel Leira Campos.
7. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 6 months and will begin on February 2019. The fellowship contract may be renewed to more 4 months, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.
8. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 745, according to table values of the fellowships awarded directly by the FCT, IP. (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).
The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and, if not covered by any social protection scheme can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, pursuant to Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social.
The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.
9. **Selection method:** Candidates will be assessed by the quality of their CV; Education (35%), experience (20%), scientific publishing (20%) and interview, limited to the best three candidates (25%).
10. **Selection Committee:** President of the jury: António Manoel Leira Campos; 1st Member - Maria da Conceição Pombo de Freitas; 2nd Member - César Augusto Canelhas Freire de Andrade; Alternative member - Mario Albino Pio Cachão.

11. **Publication/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will become public, through ordered list *final grade obtained* which will be posted at the entrance hall of the **FCiências.ID**, located at the Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, C1 bldg – 3rd floor, Campo Grande, 1749-016 Lisboa, and the ^{selected} candidate will be notified by *e-mail*.
12. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from January 18th to 31th 2019.
