

CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

One Research Fellowship

One Research Fellowship for Doctor is open at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the R&D Unit Centro de Ecologia, Evolução e Alterações Ambientais (cE3c), Ref. UID/BIA/00329/2019, financed by national funds by FCT / MCTES (PIDDAC), under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Biological Sciences (Phylogenetics and Evolutionary Biology)
2. **Requirements for admission:** The post-doc fellowship is suitable for candidates of any nationality holding a PhD degree in biology or related fields. The candidate should demonstrate knowledge of and experience in the fields of Phylogenetics and Evolutionary Biology, including on the fields of landscape genetics and conservation genetics.
3. **Factors preferred:** Excellent oral and written communication skills. A proven ability to publish in internationally recognized scientific journals is required.
4. **Work plan:** The goal of the Fellowship concerns the biogeography and evolution of Western Palearctic fauna. More specifically, during the Fellowship the researcher will: i) analyse the pan-European phylogeography and population genetics of *Mustela putorius*; ii) develop in silico trans-specific microsatellites for multiple species of hedgehogs (*Erinaceinae*).
5. **Legislation framework:** Statute of the Scientific Research Fellowship, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended and republished by Decree-Law No. 202/2012 of 27 August, and as amended by Decree-Law No. 233/2012 of 29 October and by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, and Decree-Law No. 89/2013 of 9 July; And also by the FCT, I.P. Fellowships Regulation, in force (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT.pdf>) and **FCiências.ID** Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 23rd February 2017.
6. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at Centro de Ecologia, Evolução e Alterações Ambientais (cE3c), of the Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa under the scientific guidance of the Executive Committee of the Centre, namely it's coordinator Professor Cristina Máguas.
7. **Fellowship duration:** This position is opened for three months and will begin on September, 2019, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.
8. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 1509.80, according to table values of the fellowships awarded directly by the FCT, IP. (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).
The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance.
The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.
9. **Selection method:** Candidates will be assessed by the quality of their CV, particularly the publication record (60%); and specific experience in research projects related to the call (40%); The two best candidates will be invited for an interview, in person or by videoconference, to establish the final ranking.

10. **Selection Committee:** Prof. Cristina Máguas (President of the jury), Prof. Rui Rebelo (member of the jury), Prof. Gabriela Rodrigues (member of the jury) and Prof. Paulo Borges (alternate member of the jury).
11. **Publication/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will become public, through ordered list *final grade obtained* which will be posted at the entrance hall of the **FCiências.ID**, located at the Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, C1 bdg – 3rd floor, Campo Grande, 1749-016 Lisboa, and the selected candidate will be notified by *e-mail*.
12. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from 14 of august to 28 of august of 2019.
13. **Application:** Applications may be sent via e-mail to ce3c@fc.ul.pt, by attaching the following documents:
 - a) Curriculum vitae (including a publication list and other relevant information in the context of the project research goals);
 - b) Motivation Letter (including a brief description of research experience and why you are suitable for the announced position);
 - c) Proof that the applicant meets the requirements for the respective grant - Original or certified copy of the Certificate of PhD;
 - d) Other documents that the applicant considers relevant to assessing the curriculum, including letters of recommendation

NOTE: Please note that Degrees obtained in foreign countries need a Portuguese Recognition certificate issued by a Portuguese high degree Institution, according to the [Decree-Law nr. 66/2018](#), of august 16th and the [Ministerial Order nr. 33/2019](#), of January 25th.
