

CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

One Special Regime Research Fellowships for a First Degree (Licenciatura) or a Master Degree or a PhD Degree

One Special Regime Research Fellowship for a First Degree (Licenciatura) or a Master Degree or a PhD Degree is open at **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the project/R&D institution "RUTTER – Making the Earth Global: Early Modern Nautical Rutters and the Construction of a Global Concept of the Earth", Grant Agreement nr. 833438, financed by the European Research Council (ERC), under the European Union's Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation Programme, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Informatics or Computer engineering
2. **Requirements for admission:** Applicants need to have completed a first degree (Licenciatura) or a Master Degree or a PhD in Informatics, Computer Engineering or similar. They should have knowledge of SQL and database construction and management, and Web development. Fluency in written and spoken Portuguese and English is required.
3. **Factors of preference:** Preference will be given to candidates with the higher academic degree and professional experience in database construction and development.
4. **Work plan:** Research work is to be carried out under the framework of the European Research Council Project "RUTTER – Making the Earth Global: Early Modern Nautical Rutters and the Construction of a Global Concept of the Earth", Grant Agreement nr. 833438, under the supervision of Prof. Henrique Leitão (PI). Tasks include the development of an information system, with a database of archival documents with multiple capabilities of search, and the support of Web resources.
5. **Legislation framework:** Statute of the Scientific Research Fellowship, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended and republished by Decree-Law No. 202/2012 of 27 August, and as amended by Decree-Law No. 233/2012 of 29 October and by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, and Decree-Law No. 89/2013 of 9 July; And also by the FCT, I.P. Fellowships Regulation, in force (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT.pdf>) and **FCiências.ID** Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 23rd February 2017.
6. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at the Centro Interuniversitário de História das Ciências e da Tecnologia (CIUHCT), at FCiências.ID - Faculty of Sciences, University of Lisbon, under the scientific guidance of Professor Henrique Leitão.
7. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 6 months and will begin on December, 2019. The fellowship contract may be renewed for more 51 months (57 months in total) or until the end of the project, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.
8. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 752,38-€ 1464,36 euros (first degree), € 989,70-€ 1726,93 (master degree) € 1509,38-€ 2000 (PhD degree), in accordance with the experience and academic degree of the candidate. The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and, if not covered by any social protection scheme can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, pursuant to Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social.

9. **Selection method:** Candidates will be assessed by the quality of their CV (70 %) and a Letter of Motivation explaining their fit with the objectives of the RUTTER project (30 %). The best candidates (up to three) will be invited for an interview, in person or by video-conference, to establish the final ranking.

10. **Selection Committee:** Prof. Henrique Leitão (president), Dr. Joaquim Alves Gaspar (member), Prof. Ana Simões (member), Prof. Pedro J. Freitas (substitute member), Prof. Ana Duarte Rodrigues (substitute member).

11. **Publication/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will become public, through ordered list *final grade obtained* which will be posted at the entrance hall of the **FCiências.ID**, located at the Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, C1 bldg – 3rd floor, Campo Grande, 1749-016 Lisboa, and the selected candidate will be notified by *e-mail*.

12. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from 10 to 30 October 2019.

13. **Application:** Applications may be sent via e-mail to rutter@ciuhct.org, by attaching the following documents: a) Curriculum vitae, b) Letter of Motivation explaining the interest and personal fit with the objectives of the RUTTER project, c) Certificates of Academic degrees.
