

CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

1 Research Fellowship for Doctoral student

1 Research Fellowship(s) (BI) is(are) open at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the project/R&D institution “Desenvolvimento da tarefa 3.2.3. do projeto SIARL DADOS”, financed by NOVA.id.FCT – Associação para a Inovação e o Desenvolvimento da FCT, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Geosciences

2. **Requirements for admission:** The candidates must have the following admission requisites:

- Enrolment in a Doctoral degree in the area of Geosciences;
- Master degree in the area of Geosciences.

3. **Additional optional skills and qualifications:** preferred requisites:

- Experience in Geographic Information Systems;
- Experience on georeferencing images and old cartography;
- Knowledge of coastal morpho dynamics;
- Experience in fieldwork for morphological data acquisition;
- Experience in the elaboration of technical-scientific reports.

4. **Work plan:**

1. Selection, treatment, georeferencing of old aerial images (e.g. 1958).
2. Quantification of georeferencing errors with independent tests.
3. Identification and demarcation of physiographic lines.
4. Calculation of erosion/accretion rates.
5. Support to the activities of the project task - Recolha e Tratamento de Cartografia Histórica e Produção de Linhas Fisiográficas.
6. Preparation of technical-scientific reports.

5. **Legislation framework:** Research Fellowship Holder Statute, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, in its current version and the FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, in its current version (Reg. 950/2019 published in DR on 16th December: <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>, or at the FCT website: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml>), and FCIências.ID Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 12th May 2020 (available at [Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação Científica da FCIências.ID](#)).

6. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at the Geology Department of Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa under the scientific supervision of Professor Fátima Cristina Gomes Ponte Lira.

7. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 6 months and will begin on April 2021. The fellowship contract may be potentially renewed for 18 months, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P and FCIências.ID Fellowship Regulation.

8. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 1104,64, according to [table values](#) of the FCIências.ID Fellowship Regulation.. The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and can ensure the right to

social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, if not covered by any other social protection scheme, pursuant to *Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social*. The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.

9. **Evaluation and selection process:** Candidates will be assessed by the quality of their CV and , eventually, a selection interview. If the jury chooses to carry out the selection interview, it will be carried out to the 03 (three) candidates with the best classification in the curriculum evaluation. If the selection interview is carried out, the final evaluation will be obtained considering the following weightings: 60% for the curriculum evaluation and 40% for the selection interview, tests of knowledge, recommendation letters, other; indicate the values assigned to each method or its percentage weight.

10. **Selection Committee:** Doctor Fátima Cristina Gomes Ponte Lira (President), Associate Professor Rui Pires de Matos Taborda (1.º Vogal Efetivo) and Doctor Ana Maria Almeida Nobre Silva (2.ª Vogal Efetiva). The supplementary jury members are Doctor João Pedro Veiga Ribeiro Cascalho (1.º Vogal Suplente) and Full Professor César Augusto Canêlhas Freire de Andrade (2.º Vogal Suplente).

11. **Publication/notification of results:** All the candidates will be notified by e-mail, sent by the call holder, with the selection meeting minutes enclosed.

12. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from 16/03/2021 to 24/03/2021 .

13. **Application:** Applications should be sent via e-mail to fcilira@fc.ul.pt, by attaching the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae;
- Certificate of completion of previous degree;
- Proof of registration in the study cycle that confers the requested degree in this call;
- and other documents considered relevant.

14. **Time limits for the appeal procedure:** In case of negative decision, the candidates have 10 business days, after the date of announcement of the results of the candidates evaluation, to pronounce their disagreement in accordance with the *Código do Procedimento Administrativo*. Appeals against the final decision may be submitted to the Administration Board of FCIências.ID (fciencias.id@fciencias-id.pt) within 15 business days after the notification date

Note 1: The documents that prove the entitlement of the academic qualifications and diplomas, or the proof of registration in the academic degree or diploma requested on the call, can be dismissed during the application period and replaced by a declaration on their honour from the applicant. Their delivery is mandatory during the fellowship contractualization.

NOTE 2: Please note that - higher education degrees and diplomas awarded by foreign higher education institutions need to be recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution, pursuant to the [Decree-Law nr. 66/2018](#) (August 16) and the [Ministerial Order nr. 33/2019](#) (January 25).
