

CALL FOR AWARDING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN PROJECT GRANTS AND R&D INSTITUTIONS

1 (one) Research Fellowship (BI) for PhD Student

1 Research Fellowship(s) (BI) is(are) open at the **FCiências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências**, for the project/R&D institution “Myriarch – Framework for a Multi-Internet Architecture”, “2022.09325.PTDC”, funded by the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P./MCTES through national funds (PIDDAC) under the programme Projetos de I&D em Todos os Domínios Científicos, under the following conditions:

1. **Scientific Area:** Computer Science or related areas.
2. **Requirements for admission:** Master's degree in Computer Science or in Computer Engineering or in related areas concluded.
3. **Additional optional skills and qualifications:** Solid knowledge in networking or network security; experience in software-defined networking (e.g., SDN) and network data plane programming (e.g., P4) or in cryptography; previous research experience in the areas of computer networks and/or computer security; international peer-reviewed scientific publications in the area of interest to the project. Good proficiency of spoken and written English.
4. **Contracting requirements:** Presentation of the academic qualifications and/or diplomas. Enrolment in the PhD program in Computer Science at the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Lisbon.
5. **Work plan:** The work plan will be developed within the Myriarch project and its research activities related to the development of a "Framework for a Multi-Architecture Internet". The PhD student will investigate the design of secure primitives and protocols for in-network computing applications. Among other things, this research will involve the design of more robust but practical cryptographic primitives for programmable network hardware and the design of secure protocols that embody the correct division of labour between the different network planes and between network infrastructure and end-host infrastructure.
6. **Legislation framework:** Research Fellowship Holder Statute, in accordance with Law 40/2004, of 18 August, in its current version and the FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, in its current version (Reg. 950/2019 published in DR on 16th December: <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>, or at the FCT website: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml.pt>), and FCiências.ID Fellowship Regulation, as approved on 12th May 2020 (available at [Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação Científica da FCiências.ID](#)).
7. **Place of work:** The work will be developed at the LASIGE, Faculty of Sciences of the University of Lisbon under the scientific supervision of Professor Prof. Bernardo Ferreira and Dr. Salvatore Signorello.
8. **Fellowship duration:** This position is initially opened for 6 months due to start in October 2023. The fellowship contract may be potentially renewed for until the end of the project, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation of Research Fellowships from the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.
9. **Monthly allowance:** The fellowship amounts to € 1199,64, according to [table values](#) of the fellowships awarded directly by the FCT, IP. The fellowship holder will have a personal accident insurance and can ensure the right to social security through adherence to the voluntary social insurance scheme, if not covered by any other social protection scheme, pursuant to *Código dos Regimes Contributivos do Sistema Previdencial de Segurança Social*. The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer.

10. **Evaluation and selection process:** Candidates will be assessed by CV (60%), Motivation letter (10%) and Interview (30%). (With attribution of a score on a scale of 0 to 100). Applicants whose application is scored with a final classification of less than 60 points are not eligible for granting a fellowship.

11. **Selection Committee:** President: Salvatore Signorello; Effective members: Bernardo Ferreira, Fernando Ramos (INESC-ID/IST); Substitute members: Alysso Bessani, Daniel Corujo (IT-Aveiro).

12. **Publication/notification of results:** All the candidates will be notified by e-mail, sent by the call holder, with the selection meeting minutes enclosed.

13. **Deadlines:** This call for applications is open from 02/05/2023 to 29/05/2023 .

14. **Application:** Applications should be sent via e-mail to lasige-candidaturas@listas.di.ciencias.ulisboa.pt, indicating - otherwise they will not be considered eligible - in the "Subject": Ref. 1182.1 - 1 BI ED Myriarch, by attaching the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae, with the mandatory inclusion of the degrees obtained and/or attending, course units and respective grades;
- Certificate of completion of previous degree;
- Motivation letter (max. 2 pages).

15. **Processing of personal data:** FCIências.ID – Associação para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento de Ciências, as the controller under the General Data Protection Regulation, collects and processes the personal data requested in the context indicated in paragraph 14., under the legitimate interests in ensuring the award of the research fellowship to candidates with the indicated profile.

The personal data will be kept for the period necessary for the execution of the purposes for which they are intended, being ensured the processing and protection in an appropriate and diligent way, the confidentiality and integrity of these data, through appropriate technical and organizational measures.

Personal data may be transmitted to third parties, namely the entity funding the research project, solely for the purposes specifically established. 16. **Time limits for the appeal procedure:** In case of negative decision, the candidates have 10 business days, after the date of announcement of the results of the candidates evaluation, to pronounce their disagreement in accordance with the *Código do Procedimento Administrativo*. Appeals against the final decision may be submitted to the Administration Board of FCIências.ID (fciencias.id@fciencias-id.pt) within 15 business days after the notification date

Note 2: Please note that - higher education degrees and diplomas awarded by foreign higher education institutions need to be recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution, pursuant to the [Decree-Law nr. 66/2018](#) (August 16) and the [Ministerial Order nr. 33/2019](#) (January 25).
