

# SPECIAL ACCESS – APPLICATIONS, FEES, SELECTION CRITERIA AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

<u>Note</u>: No diplomas have been awarded for Technological Specialization Courses (CET), which allow FCUL to enroll in cycles of undergraduate studies or cycles of integrated master's studies. (Point 1 of Article 7.º of <u>Decree-Law n.º 113/2014</u>, of 16<sup>th</sup> July).

<u>Note</u>: No Diplomas of Senior Technician Professional Diploma have been established that allow the entrance in the FCUL in cycles of studies of degree or integrated cycles of master's degree - (Point 1 of Article 10.º of <u>Decree-Law n.º 113/2014</u>, of 16<sup>th</sup> July).

## OVER 23 YEARS OLD AND HOLDERS OF OTHER HIGHER EDUCATION COURSES

Application Deadline: 1st July to 31st July 2019.

- For students living in Portugal, the application fee is paid by ATM reference automatically generated at the time of application submission.
  - If payment of application fee is not made by ATM reference, the application will not be considered.
- For students living abroad, the application fee is paid by bank transfer.

#### Selection criteria:

1. The best average for application to higher education.

# **Holders of other Higher Education Courses**

- 1. Can apply those who have a bachelor's degree, a master's degree and a PhD degree from another institution/course pair of Portuguese Higher Education.
- Students of Portuguese nationality, from a Member State of the European Union nationality or Students who are not covered by the International Student Statute, who are holders of equivalence/recognition of a higher academic degree obtained abroad.

## **Needed Documents to upload:**

- Identity Document optional;
- Tax File Number (TFN) optional;
- Certificate of conclusion of the degree with mention of the final classification obtained, date of conclusion and discriminated grades; (Not applicable to FCUL alumni)

#### Selection criteria:

- 1. The best average from the qualifications they hold;
- 2. In case of a tie, preference will be given to applicants that finished the course in a shorter period;
- 3. In case of a tie, preference will be given to former students of FCUL.
