2st Phase of Applications

The Master Program in Cognitive Science of the University of Lisbon has as its primary goal the training of a new generation of experts who can combine its various disciplines into an integrated science of cognition, mind and brain, as well as explore the application of the knowledge generated in this domain. To fulfil this goal, the program counts on the contribution of professors and researchers from Neuroscience (Faculty of Medicine), Cognitive Psychology (Faculty of Psychology), Computer Science (Faculty of Sciences), Linguistics (Faculty of Letters), and Philosophy of Mind and Cognition (Faculty of Letters).

1. Number of vacancies

At least 8 vacancies (figure to be determined more precisely after 1st phase registration is over, by adding eventual further remaining vacancies)

2. Admission requirements:

Admissible candidates are:

- a) Candidates holding a Portuguese bachelor degree or equivalent.
- b) Candidates holding a foreign bachelor degree granted by a State adhering to the Bologna equivalence principles.
- c) Candidates holding a foreign bachelor degree that the Scientific Committee of the program will consider as satisfying the goals of a bachelor degree.

3. Admission procedure

3.1. For foreign candidates, the application must be submitted online at the applications platform of the Faculty of Sciences

3.2. The application must include the following items:

- a) Documents certifying that the applicant meets the admission requirements mentioned above.
- b) *Curriculum vitae*, together with copy of the documents referred therein.
- c) Statement of research, specifying a research domain and the general intended attainable goals, integrating more than one of the disciplines contributing to Cognitive Science.
- d) Copy of citizen id card or passport.
- e) Receipt of application fee payment.

4. Selection Criteria

- **4.1.** The applicants are selected through the analysis of the elements mentioned in 3.2. above.
- **4.2.** The Scientific Committee of the Program, or those appointed by them, may interview the applicants.
- **4.3.** The applicants are chosen according to the score obtained in the selection process.

5. Deadlines

- 5.1. 2nd phase of applications: from August 9 to 20, 2021
- 5.2. Schedule for eventual interviews: September 3, 2021
- 5.3. Interviews (if they will be scheduled): September 6, 2021
- 5.4. Publications of results: September 8, 2021
- 5.5. Period of appeal: September 9, 2021
- 5.6. Publication of final results: September 10, 2021
- 5.7. Registration: from September 10, 2021
- 5.8. Beginning of classes: September 13, 2021











6. Fees

- **6.1.** For foreign candidates, each applicant must pay an application fee of 40 euros (non-refundable).
- 6.2. The amount of the annual fee for 2021/2022 is 1200,00 euros. This amount can be fully paid on enrollment time or gradually paid in ten instalments along the academic year (the first of which, 300 euros, at enrollment time, and the remainder of 100 euros each).
- **6.3.** The fee is paid via ATM references provided by the academic portal of the Faculty of Sciences or at the Serviços Financeiros of the Faculty of Sciences (Alameda da Universidade, 1600-548 Lisboa) during office hours.
