Additional requirements for Universität Hamburg

The sending university will screen and select candidates for exchange studies in accordance with its applicable rules and regulations. The receiving institution will accept the candidates selected by the sending institution if mutually acceptable academic and/or professional qualifications and standards are met. However, the receiving university has the right to make the final decision on the admission of candidates nominated for exchange. Admission to a specific course is subject to the exchange student being satisfactorily qualified for the chosen area of study and/or course level, and availability.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 10 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement shall become effective from the academic year 2014/15 and shall remain in effect until the academic year 2020/21. The agreement may be terminated by either contracting party giving at least six (6) months' written notice. However,

any exchange in progress will continue until completed. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

F. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

Universität Hamburg (D Hamburg01):

Universität Hamburg does not fully comply with the ECTS grading system. The grading scheme usually comprises <u>five levels</u> (with numerical equivalents; intermediate grades may be given):

- "Sehr Gut" (1) = Very Good;
- "Gut" (2) = Good;
- "Befriedigend" (3) = Satisfactory;
- "Ausreichend" (4) = Sufficient;
- "Nicht ausreichend" (5) = Non-Sufficient/Fail.

The minimum passing grade is "Ausreichend" (4). Verbal designations of grades may vary in some cases and for doctoral degrees.

<u>Universidade de Lisboa, Faculty of Sciences (P LISBOA109):</u> The Portuguese grading system expresses itself in values between 0 and 20, being 10 the minimum grade for approval.
