For the 1st semester students (Autumn term, from Sept. to February): 1st half of March

For the 2nd semester students (Spring term, from February to June): 1st half of July

For the whole academic year (from Sept. to June 2014): 1st half of July

4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination of the agreement, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. 1. Grading systems of the institutions

Fail (SS): 0–4,9.

Pass (AP): 5 to 6.9.

Good (NT): 7 to 8.9.

Excellent (SB): 9–10.

Honors: involves having obtained more outstanding special mention. They only may be awarded to students who have achieved a score equal to or greater than 9.0

A subject is considered overcome from Pass (5).
