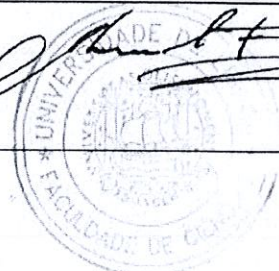
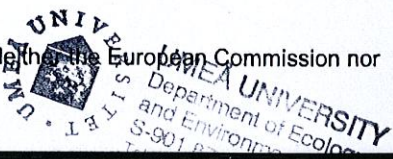
Items D, E and F are for information purposes only and are subject to change. Partners will exchange information about these matters annually by sending an information sheet covering the most relevant information concerning student mobility.
