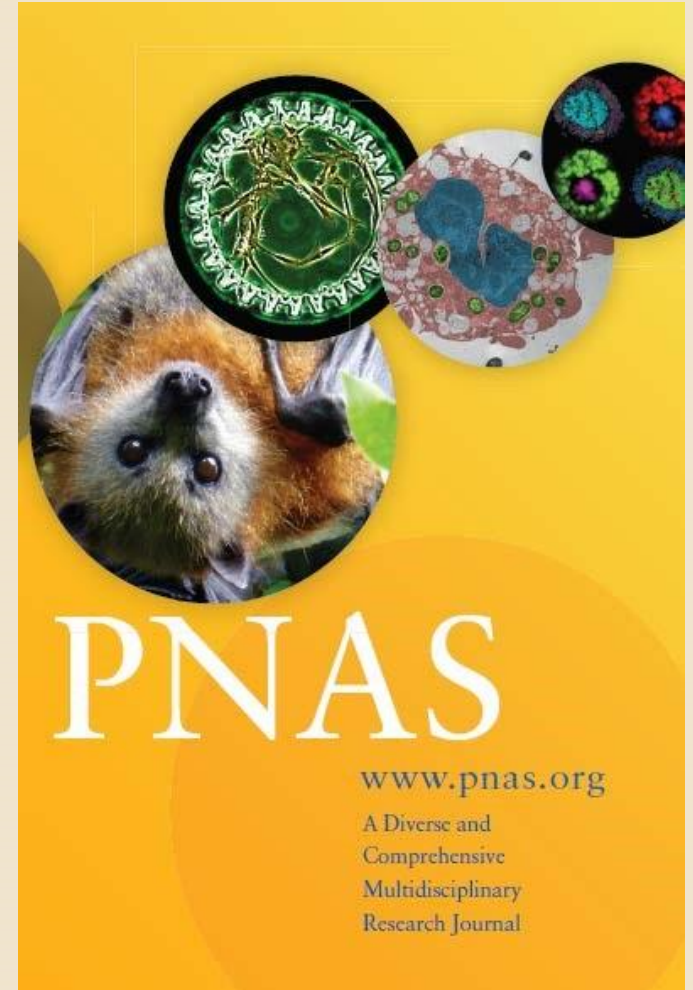

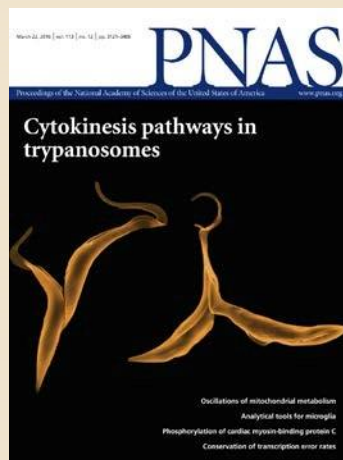
PNAS Online

- Improved readability through new formatting, content positioning, and accessible links



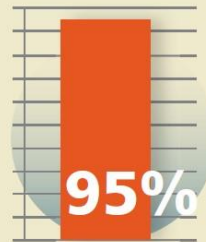
PNAS Submission

- Track your manuscript's progress online

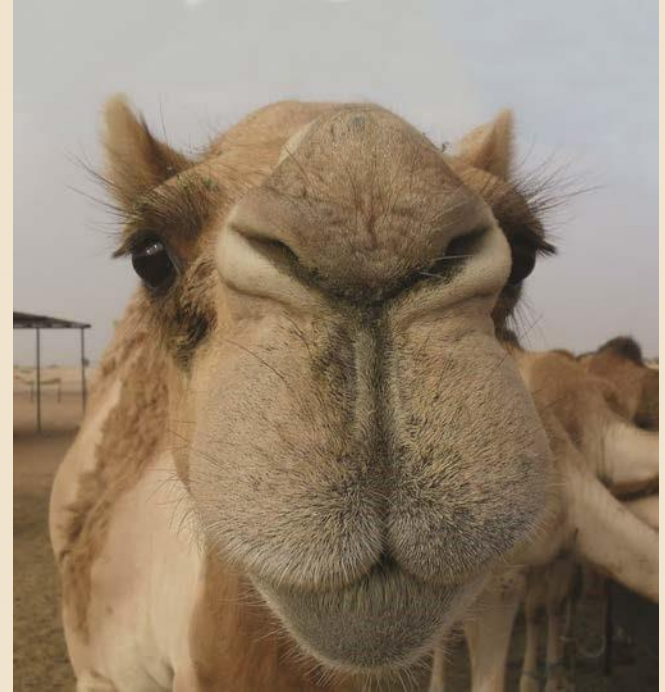

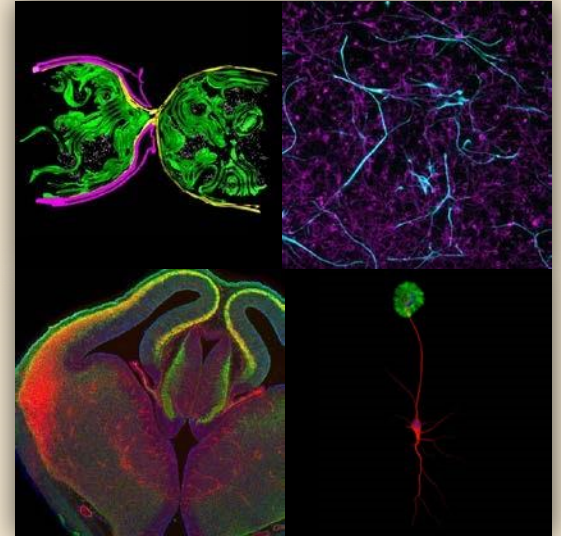
